




Lake MARION & MOULTRIE

These lakes are ranked 1st and 3rd in size among the Palmetto State's freshwaters. Both lakes have vastly different shapes and layouts, but they fish similarly. Fishing piers and boat landings are located all along the perimeter of the lakes.

The Santee Cooper lake system consists of two lakes, Marion 110,600 acres and Moultrie 60,400 acres. These two lakes are joined by the 6.5 mile diversion canal. These world-class fishing lakes were created from 1939 to 1942 for a hydroelectric project by the South Carolina Public Service Authority, commonly known as "Santee Cooper" because of the two river systems the project connected. At the present time these lakes hold a world record Channel Catfish (58 lbs). These lakes held the world records for Striped Bass until 1993, its weight was 55 lbs. and Arkansas Blue until 1996, its weight was 109.4 lbs.

The lakes vary from shallow swamps and blackwater ponds to vast open water with a multitude of underwater structures. Lake Marion was not completely cleared, as a result fishermen will find there are thousands of stumps, standing dead tree trunks and live cypress trees. Lake Moultrie is more open and is 14 miles across at its widest point. These lakes do not ice over during the winter. Weather permitting, fishing is year round.

Their range includes deep water holes and drop-offs throughout the lakes. April through October are the best months for blue catfish, Cut herring, gizzard shad, mullet, worms and commercially prepared baits are effective. Blue catfish are principally bottom feeders however, anglers land many fish trolling small lures or jigging spoons in mid depths. Channel and flathead catfish are also in the Santee Cooper lakes. Prepared baits and fishing methods are generally the same as for blue catfish.

LARGEMOUTH BASS



Spring is the best time of the year to catch big bass. Big females strike to protect beds, if small buck bass don't hit first. Spoons, spinners and six to eight inch plastic worms are effective. After spawning, worms, crankbaits and spinner baits are effective around the cypress tree stickups, fily pads and grass beds in water 2 to 4 feet deep. Bass are usually found in waters less than 20 feet deep and rarely go beyond the area where rooted vegetation will grow.

STRIPED BASS



In March, April and May stripers make their way up through the diversion canal and generally by way of the riverbeds in the lakes, up the Congaree and Wateree Rivers for their annual spawning run. As a result, fishermen concentrate on the rivers and lake Marion. During this period, live herring is the best bait followed by cut bait. The fish are concentrated in deep holes. Recommended tackle includes 8 to 9 foot rods, free spool reels with clickers and 20 to 30 pound test line.

CRAPPI

In late February, crappie congregate in mouths of creeks at depths of 8 to 12 feet. During this time, limited catches are frequently made by drift fishing with minnows. As the surface water temperature nears 58 to 64 degrees they move into water 2 to 12 feet deep to spawn. When using small jigs or spoons for crappie, jig them very slowly. Crappie weighing two pounds are common in these lakes.



BREAM begin to bed in water six inches to four feet deep as spring turns mild and will continue to bed monthly on each full moon into the fall, moving to deeper water as the days turn cooler. Crickets and worms on #6 hooks are the baits of choice. Observant fishermen can try for bream during late April and May when Mayfly hatches occur.





Lake Moultrie and Lake Marion were developed in the early 1940s by the Santee Cooper Project. During this project, the Pinopolis Dam was built on the Cooper River for flood control and hydroelectric power production. Lake Marion is named after the Revolutionary War hero General Francis Marion, also known as the Swamp fox. Lake Moultrie is named after Revolutionary War general and SC governor William Moultrie. Both lakes have a rich history and are famous for their fish population.

Embrace the beauty of these lakes with your family and friends through a variety of watersports. Rentals are available for kayaking, paddle boarding, canoeing, and boating. Public boat ramps and landings are numerous and located all around Lake Marion and Moultrie.

For the naturist, head-turning wildlife boat and kayak tours on Lake Marion and Moultrie are sensational. You can observe an abundance of wildlife up close such as: the American alligator, owls, Canadian geese, flying osprey, bald eagles, birds of prey, our state bird, the Carolina Wren, and other wild and exotic animals. 


NAVIGATION OF THE SANTEE COOPER LAKES

One of the goals of the Santee Cooper project was Charleston. The route is marked from the point where the Santee River flows into Lake Marion to the lock at the Pinopolis dam. This 122 mile system provides a clearly defined waterway through which boats can safely navigate the lakes. The navigation channel is clearly marked. Odd numbered, square, green markers define the port (left) side of the channel, while even numbered, triangular, red day markers define the starboard (right) side of the channel. Steer between these markers when navigating the channel. When encountering an oncoming boat steer to the right (starboard) side of the channel. For safety, heed rock markers and all other navigation buoys.

Please do not swim in the channel or tie off to the concrete poles that hold the channel markers. A safe channel defined by red and green buoys crosses Lake Marion at Marker #62 to the Taw Caw Creek area. A second channel runs east from the Taw Caw Creek area to the mouth of Potato and Wyboo creeks.

The same submerged trees and stumps that harbor the abundant marine life, giving these lakes legendary status for record game fish, pose a hazard to the unfamiliar boater. Please use caution when navigating outside the marked channel.

BOATING TIPS FOR A FUN DAY ON THE WATER

PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICE (PFD)

All boats must have a wearable type PFD for each person on board or being towed. Each PFD must be in good condition and readily available, and the proper size for the intended wearer. In addition, boats 16 ft. in length or longer must carry a Type IV throwable device. In SC, any person under twelve years of age must wear a US Coast Guard approved Type I, II, III, or V PFD when on board a class "A" (less than 16 ft. long) boat.

KNOW THE WATER - 1-800-925-2537

Check recent and predicted weather conditions. find out about river conditions, if water is flooded, low or normal, check for water discharge from the FIRE EXTINGUISHER One Coast Guard approved hand portable fire extinguisher must be aboard each boat less than 26 ft. if the boat is carrying passengers for hire or if the construction of the boat permits the entrapment of flammable vapors or if it has a permanently installed gas tank, including gas tanks that use any type of fastener that would hamper the immediate removal of the tank from the boat. Additional extinguishers are required in boats larger than 26 ft. Navigation lights must be on at official sunset to sunrise.

FLARES are required for vessels in coastal waters. BELLS, WHISTLES All boats less that 39.4 feet must carry an efficient sound producing device. Every vessel from 39.4 to 65.6 ft. must carry a whistle and a bell.



Santee Cooper's Pinopolis Lock on Lake Moultrie, at the Jefferies Hydroelectric Station has a single lift of 75 feet. It is 180 feet long and 60 feet wide, passing vessels from Lake Moultrie to tide level in the Tailrace Canal, Hours of operation: One-half hour after dawn until one half hour before dusk year round. Lock does not operate during thunderstorms or rough-water conditions. There are phones located on the lake and river sides of the lock. If you have a large party of boats you may want to call in advance. The phone number is (843) 899-LOCK (5625). Railroad bridge crossing the Cooper River at Strawberry is tended from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. year round. The bridge has a 10' clearance and if you need to have it opened you must notify the attendant 6 hours in advance (843) 899-7647 or (843) 761-1572 Mon-Sun, 8:30am to 4pm.






Under the Stars

Our Parks

Find your outdoor adventure in Santee Cooper at one of the many parks on the outskirts of the lakes. Countless hiking trails and nature preserves are located in state parks with safe biking trails, disc golf courses, family friendly camping and RV parking. Stroll through land-scapes of twists and turns along the colorful marsh, bring your binoculars for birding and enjoy a shaded picnic at one of the many shelters with playgrounds. For an elevated experience, wander the diverse interpretive trails, hike to refreshing waterfalls or enjoy horseback riding.

Berkeley County

Overton Park features a 400-foot beach, several shelters, and playground equipment, designed for toddlers through 12-year-olds. It is located north of Moncks Corner off U.S. Highway 52. Turn onto Powerhouse Road, then make a right at the sign to Short Stay Recreational Area, and follow the Overton Park signs from there. The park opens in late May and is open through Labor Day. Park hours are 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Admission is \$2 per person ages 4 and up. Season passes for up to four people per vehicle may be purchased for \$40.

Richardson Landing at Bonneau Beach is a six-acre public landing featuring a two-lane boat ramp, parking lot with spaces for 75 vehicles, a fishing pier, courtesy dock, retaining wall, breakwater structure, fencing and security lights.

Clarendon County

Taw Caw Park is a beautiful 37-acre park located on Taw Caw Creek near Goat Island. It features two boat ramps and three fishing piers. A boardwalk around and over the creek, picnic tables, grills, picnic shelters, playground and restrooms.

Orangeburg County

Indian Bluff Park is located 8.2 miles east of I-95 off highway 6 in Eutawville, turn left on Redbank road. The park offers a fishing pier, deep-water boat ramp, picnic tables and grills, sheltered picnic area, children's play area, boardwalk, restrooms and bathhouse.





In a large pot bring them to a boil water, vinegar, Old Bay, salt, pepper, and 1/2 Garlic. When the water begins to boil add the Catfish filets and cook for 5-7 mins., just enough time to turn the fish white. Remove the fish from the pot and set aside. Strain and save the remaining stock. In the large pot cook the bacon until crispy and set aside for garnish. Add to the bacon drippings celery, green onions, vellow onions, remaining garlic, cavenne and rosemary, stirring over medium heat until the onions and celery are translucent. Remove the rosemary sprigs before adding the remaining stock and potatoes. Bring to a slow boil until the potatoes are soft. Add the cream, sherry, and filets back to the pot. Salt and pepper to taste along with a little Louisiana Hot sauce or Texas Pete for those who like it spicy. To thicken add a tsp of cornstarch in warm water to the pot and stir. Serve with crumbled bacon bits and crackers.





A Rich History

Santee Cooper has a rich history with well-preserved archives and exhibits revealing rural farm and country life from the late 1700s-1900s. The galleries of exhibits are always changing and vary. 

So Much To See

Various historical homes, plantations, forts, mills, chapels, and museums are scattered through Santee Cooper. The museums showcase a variety of cultural artifacts and rural life of the past. You can find stimulating exhibits of art, local quilts, farming, planetariums, documents, manuscripts, and archaeology showcasing the story of life along the Santee River. Rich history of the Revolutionary War era and educational programs of the State's military tell the story of South Carolina.

The Santee National Wildlife Refuge is known for its Native American history at the Santee Indian Mound and Fort Watson Site dating back over 1,000 years. This site served as a ceremonial and burial site for the Native American Tribe, During the late 1600's and early 1700s the Santee Indians encountered Europeans sailing the Santee River. The tribe quickly reduced after initial contact with the Europeans and was eventually eradicated. During the 1800s, the mound was re-purposed by British troops and used as an elevated outpost.


